Please keep in mind the following information concerning the student artwork:

- **Drop off** student artwork on **Friday, March 19** at Adelphi University Student Center (Room 211-212) from 1-5 PM. **Late entries will not be accepted.**
- All artwork must have a **3-inch mat** or mount to accommodate our label. Do not add labels of your own to the front of the artwork. The **student's name, school district** and "**TOP**" should be written on the back of the work.
- **Label the scholarship artwork** as such on the back.
- **Do not glue or tape** release forms to the back of the artwork. Bring release forms to the drop-off site.
- **No glass or frames or 3D work** will be accepted.
- Artwork can be picked up by the teacher or supervisor at the conclusion of the exhibit on Sunday, March 21 at 4 PM or on Monday, March 22 from 2-4PM.

Finally:

- **Student** congratulatory letters and release forms will be sent with the invoice. Payment must be made no later than **March 1** on the total number of names accepted during the entry process.
